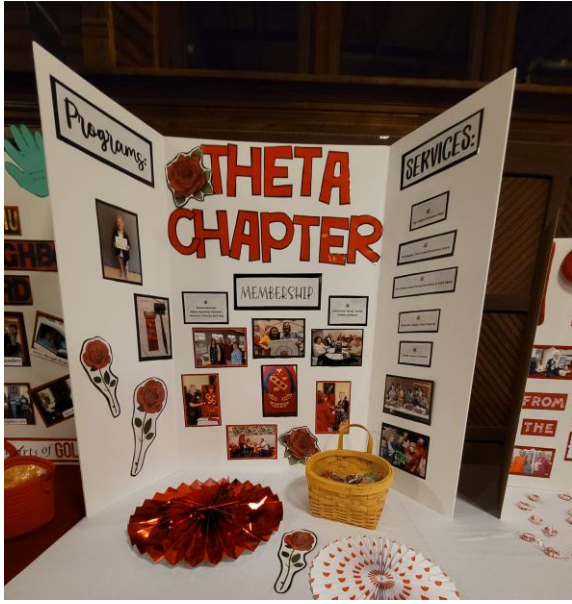

This will be a good time to invite and bring ladies to see benefits of DKG-Theta chapter. If YOU don't ask, they will never know.

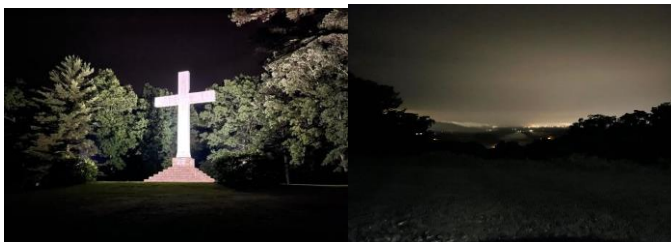
Member News
